
ORIENTEERING

 - Card (sport ident)



- A typical cache is a small waterproof container containing a logbook where the geocacher enters the date they found it and signs it with their code name.


Geocaching symbol

 Apart from ordinary two-wheeled bicycles, cycling also includes riding unicycles, tricycles, quadracycles.










History

 Tourism is travelling for recreation, sport and hobby. The purpose of tourism is to know nature, culture, sightseeing and other people.





- Since 1st January 2002, Manetin baroque chateau including its park has been proclaimed the National historic landmark.

SOFTBALL

- Softball is collective ball game, similar to baseball but pitchers throw underhand.

- Behind home plate is a 'backstop'.


History
